A SERIES ON JOB

People often say, "It's about the journey, not the destination," when their travel plans don't work out how they expected. This phrase couldn't have been more true for Job, who went through a shocking journey. In this 4-week series, kids will hear from Job's story as he learned to navigate loss and trust God's itinerary every step of the way. Through the story of Job's perseverance and faithfulness, kids will learn that **God is with them no matter what they go through, they can show God's love in small ways, God is bigger than they could ever understand, and they can trust God will make everything right.**

WEEK 1 God is with me no matter what I go through. Job 1–2:10; Hebrews 2:5–12

WEEK 3 God is bigger than we could ever understand. Job 38:1–7, 34–41; Matthew 6:25–34

This week, thank God for watching over you.



So what's your next step? Do you need to ask God to help you understand a situation? Can you release control of what's happening and trust God? Do you need reminders of how God has led you through your past experiences? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.

WEEK 4 We can trust God will make everything right. Job 42:1–17; Mark 10:46–52



Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



This week, ask God to help you believe things will be made right.



So what's your next step? Can you ask someone to share their stories of when God made things right? What other stories from the Bible could help you trust God? Who are some people who can help you grow closer to God? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.
